

# Photos for the SC Alumni Website



Suggestions for obtaining photos.

- Ask a spouse. They might love the opportunity to do something while their partner is socializing.
- Ask a parent, sibling or child to take the photos. They might enjoy seeing some of your former classmates as well.
- Ask a classmate that graduated the year before or the year after or a classmate from another Shelby County school. Offer to have a classmate from your class reciprocate at their reunion. Be sure to have a couple of classmates lined up before you make the offer.
- Ask a friend, neighbor, or a student from a camera club or computer club.
- Purchase throw way cameras. The cost is about \$11 per camera.. You can get prints and a CD. Classmates will love taking photos of each other. Be sure to announce that the photos may be posted on the SC Alumni web site. Mail the CDs to SC Alumni – 2295 Ashbrook Ln., Grayslake, IL 60030.

Notes: Don't ask a classmate, as they are there to socialize too.  
Offer the camera person (not the professional photographer) a free meal.

The person taking the pictures should have some experience taking small group photos, photos of individuals, married couples, and friends, etc. A mixture of area shots and close-ups are best. If possible, the camera person should use a digital camera and burn a CD. Mail the CD to SC Alumni – 2295 Ashbrook Ln., Grayslake, IL 60030.

The SC Alumni Liaison should provide the names of the classmate(s) and spouse(s) in each photo. A caption for some photos might be better than names. For women classmates, use either a First and Maiden name format or a First (Maiden) Married name format. List names by row (L to R, B to T) for the group photo.

The reunion committee should purchase a copy for web site if the photographer does not agree to email a jpeg file to [john@scalumni.com](mailto:john@scalumni.com).

Upon request of the reunion committee, SC Alumni will create a CD of all slide show(s) and photos of the reunion. The group photo taken by the professional photographer can not be added to the CD created by SC Alumni (it is illegal to distribute the photos). The committee may duplicate the SC Alumni CD and distribute as many copies as they wish to their classmates.
